The FCSU, GCU & Slovak Catholic Sokol Joint Bowling Tournament is fast approaching and we are pleased to offer you the following details:

Bowling... All bowling will take place at Noble Manor Lanes located at 2440 Noblestown Rd, Pittsburgh, PA 15205. The phone number is (412) 922-4622 and website is www.amf.com/location/ amf-noble-manor-lanes.

Hotel... The Pittsburgh Plaza Hotel Green Tree located at 401 Holiday Drive, Pittsburgh, PA 15220 will be the location for the Saturday Mass & Banquet Phone number is **412-922-8100**. The Hampton Inn Pittsburgh/Greentree is located less than a 1/8 of a mile from the Pittsburgh Plaza Hotel at 555 Trumbull Drive, Pittsburgh, PA 15205. Phone number is **412-922-0100**.

Bowling Schedule and Prize List... are included in this booklet. Any scheduling questions should be directed to Basil Wahal at 1-800-722-4428 ext. 3924. Please bring your copy of the schedule to the Tournament. All bowlers are asked to report to the lanes ½ hour prior to their scheduled squad time. Team Captains must verify that all Team bowlers are present and only the Team Captain will be able to register their team at the lanes on Monday. The prize list is attached to the schedule. The prizes shown pertain to all organizations. There are not separate organization prizes for FCSU, GCU and SCS bowlers.

Squad Time Assignments... All Team events will take place on Friday, May 17. Doubles and Singles events will take place on Saturday, May 18.

Average Adjustments... All average changes must be made prior to the beginning of bowling on Friday evening. If you have a change to report, please contact Jim, Kevin or Basil using the contact info below or let them know at registration prior to the team event.

Doubles & Singles Lane Change... You will bowl on the same lanes for both the Doubles and Singles events—all 6 games are bowled on the same pair of alleys. If you begin your Doubles event on Lane 19 you will start the Singles event on Lane 20. *Please note:* the Doubles Event is bowled first, immediately followed by the Singles Event. If you are only bowling Singles you will not begin bowling until the bowlers you are bowling with complete their Doubles games. Doubles only bowlers are asked to move to the back of the bowling area, once they have completed their 3 games.

Friday Evening Hospitality... All bowlers (and pre-paid guests) are welcome to join in for food and fraternalism on Friday, May 17. The hospitality buffet will be served at Noble Manor Lanes beginning at 7 PM for the 8:30 PM squad and will be refreshed as the 5:30 PM squad finishes their bowling.

Saturday Afternoon Mass... A Roman Catholic Mass will be celebrated by Fr. Tom Nasta of the FCSU at the Pittsburgh Plaza Hotel prior to the banquet at 4:30 pm. Please see the hotel event schedule that day for room information.

Saturday Evening Banquet... The banquet is by pre-ordered ticket only, because it is a sitdown meal, there will not be any tickets available to purchase at the lanes or at the banquet. Tickets for bowlers and guests will be handed out at the team event on Friday evening and to those not bowling in the team event on Saturday at the doubles & singles event. Tickets will also have your entree selection on them, so you must have it when you sit down at your banquet table. The tickets will have two stubs attached that can be used at the bar for drinks. The bar will be cash once you use your two free drink tickets.
